5. Abraham Passed His Test

Genesis 22:1-19 CEV

Some years later God decided to <u>test Abraham</u>, so he <u>spoke</u> to him. Abraham answered, "Here I am, LORD."

The LORD said, "Go get <u>Isaac</u>, your only <u>son</u>, the one you <u>dearly</u> love!
