John 4: 6-7, 9a, 10-15, 21, 23-27a, 28-30, 39-42 NLT

Jacob's <u>well</u> was there; and Jesus, tired from the <u>long walk</u>, sat <u>wearily</u> beside the well about <u>noontime</u>. Soon a <u>Samaritan</u> woman came to draw water, and Jesus said to her, "Please give me a drink." The woman was <u>surprised</u>, for Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans ...

Jesus replied, "If you only knew the gift God has for you and who you are speaking to, you would ask me, and I would give you living water."

... "But sir, you don't have a <u>rope</u> or a <u>bucket</u>," she said, "and this well is very deep. Where would you get this living water? And besides, do you think you're greater than our ancestor Jacob, who gave us this well? How can you offer <u>better water</u> than he and his sons and his animals enjoyed?"
