## 63. Peter Spoke - 3,000 Saved at Pentecost

## Acts 2:14, 22-41 CEV

Peter stood with the eleven apostles and spoke in a loud and clear voice to the crowd ... Now, listen to what I have to say about Jesus from Nazareth. God proved that he sent Jesus to you by having him work miracles, wonders, and signs. All of you know this. God had already planned and decided that Jesus would be handed over to you. So you took him and had evil men put him to death on a cross. But God set him free from death and raised him to life. Death could not hold him in its power. What David said are really the words of Jesus,

"I always see the Lord <u>near</u> me, and I will not be afraid with him at my right side. Because of this, my heart will be glad, my words will be joyful, and I will live in <u>hope</u>.

The Lord won't leave me in the grave. I am his holy one, and he won't let my body decay. He has shown me the path to life, and he makes me glad by being near me." My friends, it is right for me to <a href="speak">speak</a> to you about our <a href="ancestor">ancestor</a> David. He died and was <a href="buried">buried</a>, and his <a href="tomb">tomb</a> is <a href="still">still</a> here. But David was a prophet, and he knew that God had made a promise he would not <a href="buried">break</a>. He had told David that someone from his own family would someday be king. David knew this would happen, and so he told us that Christ would be raised to life. He said that God would not <a href="leave">leave</a> him in the grave or let his body <a href="decay">decay</a>. All of us can tell you that God has raised Jesus to life!

Jesus was taken up to sit at the right side of God, and he was given the Holy Spirit, just as the <u>Father</u> had promised. Jesus is also the one who has given the Spirit to us, and that is what you are now seeing and hearing. <u>avid</u> didn't go up to heaven. So he wasn't <u>talking</u> about himself when he said, "The Lord told my Lord to sit at his right <u>side</u>, until he made my Lord's enemies into a <u>footstool</u> for him." Everyone in Israel should then know for certain that God has made Jesus both Lord and Christ, even though you put him to death on a cross. When the people heard this, they were very <u>upset</u>. They asked Peter and the other <u>apostles</u>, "Friends, what shall we do?"

Peter said, "Turn back to God! Be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ, so that your <u>sins</u> will be <u>forgiven</u>. Then you will be given the Holy Spirit. This <u>promise</u> is for you and your children. It is for everyone our Lord God will choose, no <u>matter</u> where they live."

Peter told them many other things as well. Then he said, "I beg you to save yourselves from what will <u>happen</u> to all these evil people." On that day about <u>three</u> thousand believed his message and were baptized.
