7. The Walls of Jericho Came Down

Joshua 6:1-2, 8-21

Now <u>Jericho</u> was <u>straitly</u> shut up because of the children of Israel: <u>none</u> went out, and none came in. And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the <u>mighty</u> men of <u>valour</u>.

And it came to pass, when Joshua had spoken unto the <u>people</u>, that the <u>seven</u> priests bearing the seven <u>trumpets</u> of rams' <u>horns</u> passed on before the LORD, and blew with the trumpets: and the ark of the covenant of the LORD followed them.

And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward came after the ark, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

And Joshua had commanded the people, saying, Ye shall not <u>shout</u>, nor make any <u>noise</u> with your <u>voice</u>, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout. So the ark of the LORD compassed the city, going about it once: and they came into the camp, and <u>lodged</u> in the <u>camp</u>.

And Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priests took up the ark of the LORD. And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the ark of the LORD, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

And the second day they compassed the city once, and returned into the camp: so they did \underline{six} days. And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times.

And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for the LORD hath given you the city.

And the city shall be accursed, even it, and all that are therein, to the LORD: only <u>Rahab</u> the <u>harlot</u> shall live, she and all that are with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent.

And ye, in any <u>wise</u> keep yourselves from the accursed thing, lest ye make yourselves accursed, when ye take of the <u>accursed</u> thing, and make the camp of Israel a curse, and trouble it.

But all the silver, and gold, and <u>vessels</u> of <u>brass</u> and <u>iron</u>, are consecrated unto the LORD: they shall come into the treasury of the LORD.

So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the <u>wall</u> fell down <u>flat</u>, so that the people went up into the city, <u>every</u> man straight before him, and they took the city.

And they utterly destroyed all that was in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox, and sheep, and <u>ass</u>, with the <u>edge</u> of the sword.
